

Introduction

Once you have [signed up](#) and logged in to the Account Center, it's time to create an Integration. This will create an API key for use on your application and allow you to configure settings based on your requirements.

Creating an Integration

To start, navigate to *Integrations* from the menu and click the *New +* button. From here, select the integration type that is most relevant.
